Abstract

Energrow provides Canadian -built farm-scale oil pressing systems. These unique systems enable farmers to take control of their own commodity through direct on-farm processing of high energy and quality bioproducts.

Energrow oil presses produce two main products: meal, a freshly pelletized, high energy and palatable feed, and oil, for use in feed, lubrication, crop spray, and even in direct diesel fuel applications. Through the production and use of these products (both on and off farm), producers are able to significant value to their crops.

The seminar will discuss the process of on-farm oil pressing, the bioproducts and their applications, as well as discuss examples of recent installations and their value to the farmers.
